The intent of the Glendale Club is to implement and establish an 'AMA only' flying site for its members. This means to fly at Glendale Field you must be a member of that club and an AMA member. You must abide by the AMA flying site rules at all times in order to maintain your club membership. As a member, when flying, the Glendale Field membership card must be displayed on your person at all times in order to be a flying pilot at this field.. Your guests and family are not allowed to fly. If this rule is not adhered to your membership will be terminated.

Flight venue is limited to .40 size nitro and electrical fixed wing, helicopters and small drones. No FPV aircraft or racing airplanes are allowed. Limit your altitude to 400 feet.

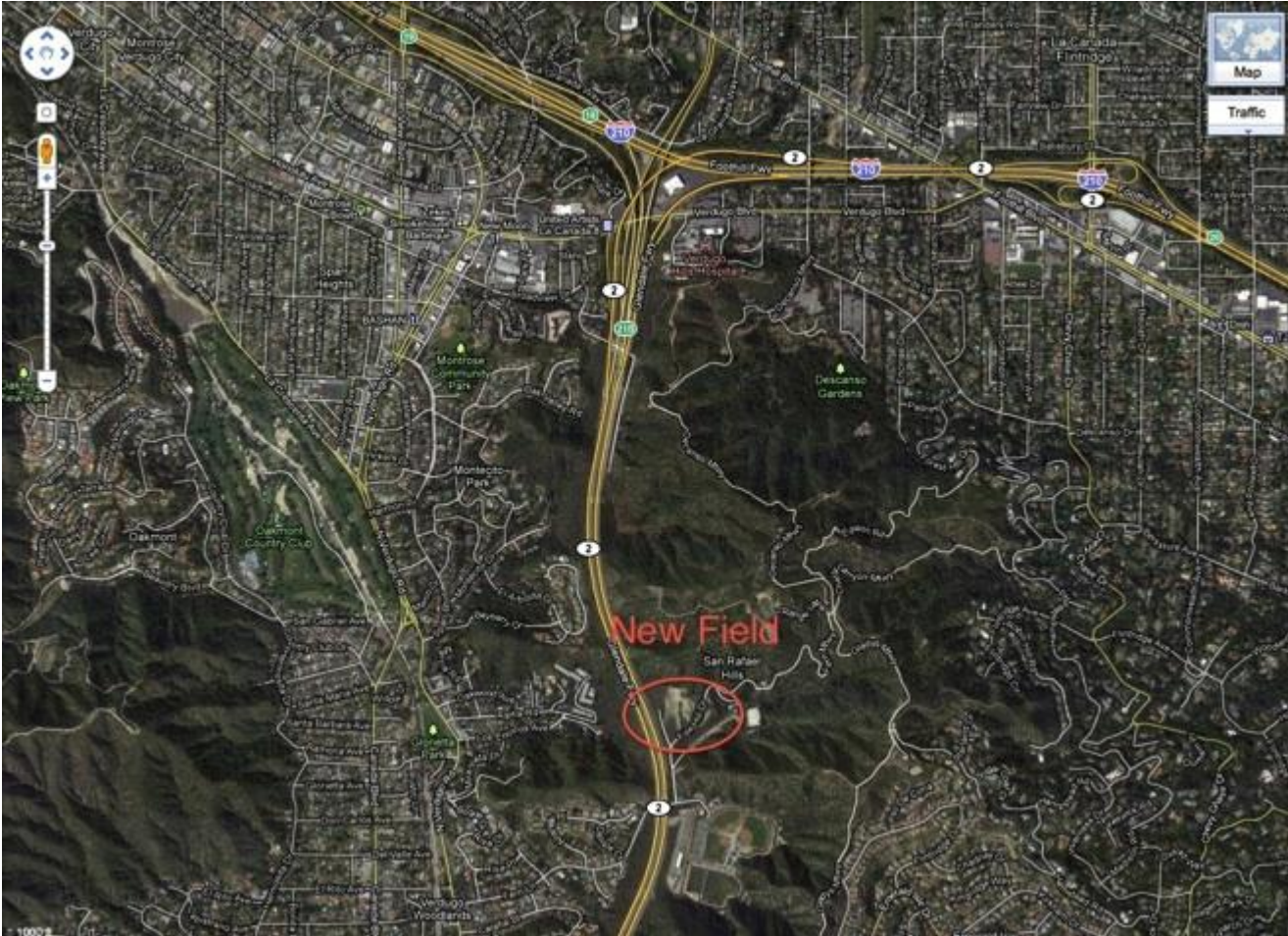
