Well it finally happened...The Valley Flyers added another first to the growing list for "1965"....The only "REEDS" at the Annual Contest were Howard Reed and Reed Packard.....Manufacturers presented included Kraft, Bonner, Logictrol, Space Control, Micro Avionics and Deans.....You know the competition was tough when you have guys like Phil Kraft, Doug Spreng, Jerry Pullen and Bill Williams finishing ou of the money. When all the dust had settled Clarence Lee emerged the victor in Class III Expert, it must have something to do with a home

field advantage. Champ Cliff Weirick and Jerry Krause tied for second which called for a Valley Flyer patented matched flight which was the high point of the week-end as far as the spectators were concerned. Both pilots fly simultaneously and the three judges only have to decide which flyer performed the maneuver better. It's a sure way for breaking ties.....

In Class III novice another Valley Flyer took first place when Bill Dennis came through with his Ugly Stik. (That's an airplane girls). Consistency payed off for Granger Williams in Goodyear Pylon when he overcame both the other flyers and the officials.
